What is SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)?

According to RI DHS Website, "SNAP, formerly called food stamps, is the nation's largest program for fighting domestic hunger. Federally funded and state administered through our Department, we are committed to providing low-income individuals and families with resources to purchase food."

What is WIC (Women Infants and Children)?

According to the RI Department of Health, "WIC is a public health program that improves birth outcomes and children's long term health outcomes. WIC does not ask immigration status and is not a part of Public Charge. WIC benefits provide you and your child with one-on-one nutrition counseling, referrals with services you may need, and a food prescription to meet your needs, and your child's specific needs. As long as you are in the WIC program, we will meet with you to celebrate the steps in your child's growth and learning. Women who apply early in their pregnancy are more likely to have a healthy baby. Children who stay on WIC until the age of five, are better prepared and more likely to succeed in school."
